RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ (2022)

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Indian Police Department (CIPD) is dedicated to serving and protecting the citizens of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians and keeping Tribal trust land safe and secure; and

WHEREAS, the CIPD has determined that it needs to add 16 positions to the department to meet the needs of our communities and the expectations of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee has reviewed and approved this request for 16 new positions and the Human Resources Division (HR) has reviewed and approved the position descriptions; and

WHEREAS, HR and Tribal Council require all divisions that want to add or subtract positions to amend their organizational charts to reflect the changes before the positions; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe's Office of Budget and Finance requires positions to be certified so funding can be budgeted, and the budgets for all Tribal programs are subject to Tribal Council review and approval each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the proposed, revised organizational charts for the CIPD in FY22 are attached to this resolution for review and approval by Tribal Council.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, at which a quorum is present that Tribal Council approves the addition of the new positions for the Cherokee Indian Police Department and the Corrections Program, as described in this resolution and in the attached organizational charts, and identified as follows:

- Program Code 103 - Cherokee Indian Police Department**
  - Detective (1) reporting to Sergeant – Investigations
  - Assistant Chief of Police (1) reporting to Chief of Police
  - Patrol Officer (10) reporting to Sergeant – Patrol
  - Victim Advocate (1) reporting to Lieutenant – Investigations
- Program Code 109 - Corrections Program**
  - Compliance Officer (1) reporting to Jail Administrator
  - Maintenance Technician (2) reporting to Jail Administrator

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians does hereby approve sufficient funding to the positions, such funding is or shall be appropriated, and the Office of Budget and Finance is authorized to fund the positions.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that all prior resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby rescinded, in whole or in part as may be necessary to resolve the conflict, and the Principal Chief, Human Resources, Office of Budget and Finance, and the Cherokee Indian Police Department, including the Corrections Program, are authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution.
