

1 CHEROKEE COUNCIL HOUSE 2 CHEROKEE, NORTH CAROLINA 3 4 Date: 5 6 **RESOLUTION NO.** _____ (2025) 7 8 A resolution authorizing the purchase of approximately 5.716 acres of deeded property located 9 in the Jackson County, North Carolina. 10 WHEREAS, Sequoyah National Golf Club II, LLC ("Sequoyah National") would like to 11 12 purchase 5.716 acres in Jackson County North Carolina from Samuel and Jean 13 Spangenberg. 14 15 WHEREAS, the property is more specifically described in Deed Book 532, Page 214 recorded in the Jackson County Register of Deeds and is attached to this resolution along 16 17 with a GIS map; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the purchase is necessary to provide sewer services to the Sequoyah National Golf 20 Course; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the purchase price for the 5.716 acres is Four-Hundred and Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$495,000.00); and 23 24 25 WHEREAS, Sequoyah National and the Tribe have agreed that Sequoyah National will provide Four-Hundred and Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents 26 (\$435,000.00) towards the purchase and that the Tribe will provide Sixty 27 Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$60,000.00); and 28 29 30 WHEREAS, the Lands Acquisition Committee approved the purchase and the source of funds 31 at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 12, 2025. 32 33 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of 34 Cherokee Indians assembled, at which a quorum is present, that the Tribal Council hereby approves the purchase by Sequovah National Golf Club II, LLC 35 of the 5.716 acres, more or less, located in Jackson County, North Carolina which 36 parcel is described above for the purchase price of Four Hundred Ninety-Five 37 Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$495,000.00). 38 39 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians of Cherokee Indians will contribute Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) for the purchase of the 5.716 41 42 acres on the condition that Sequoyah National provides Four-Hundred and Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$435,000.00). 43 44 45 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians approves the cost for due diligence and closing costs which includes, surveying, title insurance, Phase I 46 47 environmental assessment, home inspection, and attorney fees and recording fees.
