Resolution No. _____ (2016)

WHEREAS; Graham County Indian Education provides tutoring and advice services on a daily basis throughout the school year, and has provided these services for many years, they would like to teach the youth Cherokee Traditional Arts and Crafts through an eight week Summer Arts Camp. Through this Camp our students, and staff will acquire the knowledge and cultural awareness of our elders and artisans, who are skilled in the Traditional Arts and Crafts;

WHEREAS; Graham County Indian Education has identified a funding source that will help fund a Summer Arts Camp that will cultivate a true sense of Culture and Traditional Arts and Crafts that will be learned and preserved for generations;

WHEREAS; the Grant Budget allows for five salaries for Assistants not to exceed \$16,840 and there are no further requirements from the grantor once the grant project is completed;

WHEREAS; to continue to receive these funds and application is required once the grant project is completed, if the funds are not awarded by next fiscal year we are not obligated to fund these position;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians at which a quorum is present that the Graham County Indian Education Program shall commit a 18% match totaling \$10,309.30 (in-kind \$4,772.50 and GF Tribal Match \$5,536.80) and be authorized to submit an application package to the Cherokee Preservation Foundation in the amount of \$47,680.95 for FY2016.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Principal Chief is authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution, which shall remain in effect until implemented or rescinded.
