11	WHEREAS,	Section 16 of the Charter and Governing Document states that Tribal Council
12	WILKLAS,	"shall direct the management and control of all property, either real or personal,
13		belonging to the Tribe"; and

15	WHEREAS,	the Tribe has many properties and locations that are historically and culturally
16		important to the Tribe, and which are located on Tribal trust land or deeded land
17		owned by the Tribe or an entity of the Tribe; and
18		
19	WHEREAS,	the Tribe does not have a coordinated approach for managing these properties and
20		locations, educating the public about their historic and cultural value, and
21		developing uniform signage for installation at the properties or locations; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Tribe will benefit by designating a Tribal program or entity that will have the
23 24	WHEREAS,	responsibility to identify, catalogue and manage the Tribe's historically and
25		culturally important properties, and to develop a system of uniform interpretative
26		signs for installation at the properties.

28	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cheroke	
29		Indians, in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that the Principal
30		Chief, in consultation with Tribal Council, shall identify an existing, appropriate
31		Tribal division, program, board or committee that will have the responsibility to
32		identify, catalogue and coordinate management of the Tribe's historically and
33		culturally important properties, and to develop a system of uniform interpretative
34		signs for installation at the properties.
35	DE IT EINA	LLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are
36 37	DE II FIINA	rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the
38		Principal Chief.
