(2025) 8 9 A resolution to exclude Earl Germaine Gresham from the lands of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians. 10 11 WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians ("EBCI" or "Tribe") has the sovereign 12 13 authority to exclude persons from lands of the Eastern Band to protect the 14 integrity, law and order of the lands, and the welfare of Tribal members: and 15 WHEREAS. the Tribal Council has codified its authority to exclude persons from the lands of 16 17 the Eastern Band at Chapter 2 of the Cherokee Code; and 18 WHEREAS, the power to exclude is an inherent and essential part of Tribal sovereignty that is 19 indispensable to the Tribe's autonomy and self-governance; and 20 21 WHEREAS, EARL GERMAINE GRESHAM (Date of Birth: 11/11/1977) is not a member of 22 the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, but is said to be residing in and around the 23 Qualla Boundary; and 24 25 WHEREAS, On 06/23/2025 at approximately 8:56 PM, Cherokee Indian Police Officers, were 26 dispatched to 749 Painttown Rd. to investigate a report of larceny by Gresham. 27 Gresham is a known trespasser at the casino and has been charged upwards of ten 28 times for the same offense at this location.: and 29 30 WHEREAS, during the investigation, CIPD found GRESHAM in possession of nearly \$1,000 31 32 worth of stolen goods. As of 06/23/2025, GRESHAM again has been charged with Second degree trespassing, two counts of Felony Financial Transaction Card 33 theft, and multiple counts of larceny; and 34 35 WHEREAS. GRESHAM'S criminal history includes multiple trespassing charges, multiple 36 theft charges, multiple possession of firearm by felon charges, probation 37 violations, battery, willful obstruction of law enforcement officers, and has been a 38 fugitive from justice; and 39 40 WHEREAS, GRESHAM does not appear to have any legitimate business/reasons the be on the 41 Qualla Boundary. With his criminal history and disregard for the laws of the 42 EBCI, GRESHAM poses threat to the welfare, safety, health, and peace of the 43 members of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians. 44 45 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council, in Council assembled 46 47 with a quorum present, and with the number of votes required by Tribal law.

ļ	EARL GERMAINE GRESHAM is hereby PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED from
2	all Tribal lands and is hereby notified and ordered to vacate all tribal lands.
3	
4	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this permanent exclusion prohibits
5	EARL GERMAINE GRESHAM from entering or being present on Tribal lands
6	for any purpose except as required by Tribal Council or Tribal Court.
7	
8	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if EARL GERMAINE GRESHAM is found improperly on
9	Tribal lands at any time after the effective date of this resolution, he shall be
10	treated as a trespasser and appropriate legal action shall be taken against him.
11	
12	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded,
13	and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal
14	Chief.
