RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2025)

WHEREAS, parcel 75 is a forested tract of possessory holding located on Sim Taylor Road, it is located at 35.486242 N, 83.361454 W, and approximately 3.5 miles west of the Bureau of Indian Affairs Agency Office and,

WHEREAS, possessory holdings compromise 90% of EBCI lands and it is Tribal Policy that no cutting is done on possessory holdings without the permission of the possessory holder (Resolution 443, 1985) and,

WHEREAS, a previous timber harvest was completed within this parcel about 25 years ago creating limited logging access roads, and,

WHEREAS, the trees in this location are valuable enough to re-open and repair the existing logging road system into the parcel to access and remove some of the mature trees, leaving good growing stock and creating conditions for natural regeneration, this is an 87 acre parcel with a harvestable area of 57 acres

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that Tribal Council approves the advertised sale of Parcel 75, a period of 15-30 days is recommended for sale advertisement

BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED that Tribal Members will have priority when bidding and sale will be by sealed bids only

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective upon signature of the Principal Chief
