WHEREAS, the Administratrix requests Tribal Council recognize the deceased's eligible heirs under Tribal law, and to provide for the distribution of the deceased's possessory holdings to her eligible heirs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Wolfetown Community Parcel No. 681 (Part of Parcel No. 288), containing 0.919 acres, more or less, together with all improvements located thereon, be assigned to Bruce Kenneth Lambert (enrolled), Jo Ann Sampson Notargiacomo (enrolled), Marietta Louise Sampson Toineeta (enrolled), Dorothy Lee Sampson (enrolled), and Enoch Sampson Crow, Jr. (enrolled).

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

Whenever possible, include the name, allotment number, if any, age, residence, tribe, and relationship of each devisee, specific description of lands devised, and in case of inherited interests the name and allotment number, of original alottee and interest of testator therein. 5. Explain fully to testator that fractional interests are of little or no value to a devisee if further divided, and that the entireinterest in a specific piece of land is much more, valuable than a fractional interest. The testator does not have to give the residue to "my heirs at law," he can give the residue to my neurs at law, ne can give the residu-to one person if he wishes.
