Resolution No. _____ (2026)

WHEREAS, Jimmy Bradley is an enrolled member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians and his residence was built in 1967 by his father, and,

WHEREAS, his residence is located inside of Bradley's Campground, which is bordered by Acquoni Road and the Oconaluftee River, and,

WHEREAS, since 2006 his residence has begun to develop black mold and has incurred water intrusion from the ground, and,

WHEREAS, the home was originally a four-bedroom home at the time of the construction in 1967 and it has since been reduced to a three-bedroom home so the appraisal of the home will not be the same as it would have in 2006, and,

WHEREAS, in 2006 when the black mold began to settle the house is condemned and he would like to replace the home his father built

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that Council hereby approves and instructs the _____ office to assist Mr. Bradley with the proper steps to replace his current residence with a home of his choice not to exceed the amount of _____

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution shall become ratified upon signature of the Principal Chief
