Section 117-19 – Contract with the Tribe, shall be amended to read as follows;

Sect. 117-19 Contracts with Tribe

WHEREAS: Before a Contract with the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians shall be valid and binding the following shall occur:

- (a) (i) A Contract in an amount less than \$50,000 which complies with all budget, financial, and legal requirements for that program and the Tribe, and is within the fiscal parameters of the Annual Budget approved by Tribal Council, will have the signature of the Tribal Council Chairman before it may be executed by the Principal Chief; or
- (ii) A Contract in an amount of \$50,000 or more which complies with all budget, financial and legal requirements for that program and the Tribe, and is within the fiscal parameters of the Annual Budget approved by Tribal Council, shall have the approval of the Business Committee before being executed by the Principal Chief.

(b) All Contracts shall bear the signature of the Tribal Council Chairman and Principal Chief before they are valid and binding by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that the above redlined changes are hereby adopted.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief.
