| 13 | WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (EBCI) is a federally recognized, sovereign |
| 14 15 | tribal nation with powers of self-governance and jurisdiction over lands held in trust for the |
| 16 | benefit of the Tribe and its citizens; and |
| 17 | beliefit of the Tribe and its effizens, and |
| 18 | WHEREAS, the EBCI previously received settlement funds from Duke Energy in response to |
| 19 | damages resulting from the Stony Ridge Fire, with said funds held in EASTERN CHEROKEE |
| 20 | INDIANS NORTH CAROLINA - 7224 -S52/001 (Account No. PL7224709) for use in |
| 21 | activities that promote restoration, environmental protection, and fire prevention; and |

| 23 | WHEREAS, wildfire prevention and sustainable land management remain essential |
| 24 | responsibilities of Tribal governance, especially in light of ongoing climate threats and increased |
| 25 | risk to natural and cultural resources; and |

| 27 | WHEREAS, the Sennebogen Tree Care Handler is a specialized piece of heavy equipment |
| 28 | designed to perform safe and efficient tree removal, large-scale vegetation management, and |
| 29 | hazard mitigation, especially in rugged and fire-prone terrain; and |
| 30 31 | WHEREAS, acquisition of this equipment will significantly strengthen the Tribe's capacity to |
| 32 | reduce wildfire risk, support emergency response, and promote long-term forestry resilience |
| 33 | across Tribal trust lands; and |

| 35 | WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Bureau of Indian Affairs - Cherokee Agency has |
| 36 | reviewed and formally expressed support for the Tribe's intent to purchase this equipment as an |
| 37 | appropriate and strategic investment in forestry safety and land management; and |

| 39 | WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that purchasing this equipment constitutes a responsible |
| 40 | and effective use of settlement funds, in accordance with the original purpose of the Stony Ridge |
| 41 | Fire settlement. |
