WHEREAS; the right of way that she is requesting crosses parcel no. 262-M in the Painttonw community and is owned by heirs of Dorcas Smith and;

WHEREAS; her siblings have already agreed to sign but the recent deaths of her aunts children and grandchildren have delayed the division for unknown reasons

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that Lucy S. Reed be granted right of way at her parcel 393 through 262-M without the signatures of Caroline Winstead; Sharon Smith; Chasity Solis; and Kyra Smith

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this legislation shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief
