WHEREAS, The Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians established the Tribal Alcoholic Beverage

Control Commission by Ordinance 768 on September 8, 2011, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Alcoholic Beverage Commission was established as an independent entity of the Tribe to further promote the sovereignty of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians; and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to amend Cherokee Code Chapter 18B by adding a new section to require annual training for all permittees issued a retail permit by the Tribal ABC Commission;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians assembled, at which a quorum is present, that Cherokee Code Chapter 18B is amended by adding a new section to read:

## "Sec. 18B-206. - Mandatory Annual Training.

Every permittee issued a retail permit for the sale or service of alcoholic beverages on tribal lands shall be required to attend training on an annual basis to receive updates on current ABC laws, ABC Rules, and compliance with Tribal ABC Commission policies."

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this amendment shall be effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief, and all prior ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with this ordinance are rescinded.
