Resolution No. _____ (2024)

WHEREAS; the Charter and Governing Document gave Tribal Council the authority to establish a Board of Elections. Charter and Governing Document of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians sec.6 (1986).

WHEREAS, the Board of Elections shall have six members, one from each township. C.C. §161-17(a).

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council appoints each Board Member effective September 1 in non-election years and terms run four years.

WHEREAS, the Wolfstown/Big Y Community Board member term ended August 31, 2024. Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Resolution 278 (2020)

WHEREAS, there is a vacancy on the Board of Elections for the Wolfstown/Big Y Community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Annual Council assembled at which a quorum is present, the Tribal Council appoints and approves, _____, to the Board of Elections as the Wolfstown/BigY Community representative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that _____ shall be appointed to serve the term of September 1, 2024, through August 31, 2028.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that _____ is an Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians enrolled member; at least 18 years of age; resided on Cherokee Trust Land for at least one year prior to their appointment date; and possess a high school diploma or equivalent. C.C. §161-(b).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED this resolution shall become effective upon ratification.
