RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2015)

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (“the Tribe”) has identified the need of its enrolled members for land suitable on which to build homes on the Qualla Boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (“the Tribe”) purchased Big Cove Community Parcel No. 669, containing 14.83 acres, more or less, in accord with Tribal Council Resolution No. 1068 (2007).

WHEREAS, the Tribe’s Housing and Community Development Division now requests to offer Big Cove Community Parcel No. 669-D (Part of Parcel No. 669) containing 2.109 acre, more or less, to enrolled member Larissa Rae Teesateskie, and

WHEREAS, A satisfactory Title Status Report showing clear title to the property and a positive Environmental and Archaeological reports have been issued showing no reason to impede the Division’s Sale of the property; and

WHEREAS, the Qualla Housing Board of Commissioners approved the sale of Big Cove Community Parcel No. 669-D (Part of Parcel No. 669) containing 2.109 acre, more or less to Larissa Rae Teesateskie for the sale price of \$500.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians assembled, at which a quorum is present, that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the sale of the above described property, at the agreed upon price of \$500.00, to Larissa Rae Teesateskie.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Housing and Community Development Division and the Business Committee of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians are hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
