1 CHEROKEE COUNCIL HOUSE 2 CHEROKEE, NORTH CAROLINA 3 OCT 1 1 2021 Date: 4 5 6 RESOLUTION NO. 10 (2022) 7 8 A resolution to prepare for the 22^{nd} century in light of new climate science data, phase 1. 9 10 11 WHEREAS, our people have inhabited this planet and landscape for thousands of years prior to 12 colonial contact; and, 13 14 WHEREAS, technological advancements and cultural supplantation has drastically changed 15 16 our way of life and is altering our biosphere; and, 17 18 WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, Sixth Assessment Report, Working Group 1: The Physical Science Basis report released in August 2021 19 20 addresses the most up-to-date physical understanding of the climate system and climate change, bringing together the latest advances in climate science, and 21 22 combining multiple lines of evidence from paleoclimate, observations, process 23 understanding, and global and regional climate simulations; and, 24 25 WHEREAS. scientist are observing changes in the earth's climate in every region and across the whole climate system and many of the changes observed in the climate are 26 unprecedented in thousands, if not hundreds of thousands of years, are some of 27 28 the changes already set in motion, such as continued sea level rise, are 29 irreversible; and, 30 WHEREAS, the report signals that we, of a human species, are unequivocally responsible for 31 32 widespread and rapid changes in the atmosphere, ocean, cryosphere and 33 biosphere; and, 34 WHEREAS, the increase in the average global temperature is resulting in more frequent and 35 more intense weather patterns, in addition to reductions in Artic sea ice, snow 36 37 cover and permafrost, that is impacting our lives now and into the future; and 38 the Cherokee outlook for future generations is to plan for seven generations in 39 WHEREAS, 40 advance to ensure our progeny and descendants are able to enjoy the same level opportunities in the future, or greater, and that the environment in which we 41 42 occupy will be as fruitful then as is it now; and 43 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of 44

Cherokee Indians, in Council assembled at which a quorum is present, that the
