28	WHEREAS,	Dr. Salyers has brought a lifetime of commitment to public health, with decades
29		of service spanning direct patient care, public health leadership, emergency
30		preparedness, epidemiology, and policy development; and
31 32	WHEREAS,	since June 2011, Dr. Salyers has dedicated herself to the Cherokee people,
33	WILKEAS,	particularly through her work with the Public Health and Human Services
34		Division, where she brought her vast expertise to support and guide
35		transformational efforts in Tribal public health; and

37	WHEREAS,	as a medical doctor, friend, and advocate, she consistently elevated the strengths
