RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2024)

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (EBCI) Senior Citizens Program strives to ensure that seniors and people with disabilities can receive the assistance they need; and

WHEREAS, the Senior Citizens Program has identified a funding opportunity from the Cherokee Preservation Foundation that would provide funding for all cultural activities for FY26 to allow seniors to share and learn traditional ways of Cherokee life; and

WHEREAS, no personnel costs will be covered by this grant; and

WHEREAS, there is a grant match required in the estimated amount of \$15,000.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in Council assembled and at which a quorum is present, that the EBCI Senior Citizens Program is authorized to apply for and accept funds from the Cherokee Preservation Foundation in the estimated amount of \$15,000 for a total project cost of \$30,000 for FY26.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the EBCI will contribute a grant match in the estimated amount of \$15,000 from in-kind sources.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Principal Chief is authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution, which shall remain in effect until implemented or rescinded.
