WHEREAS; the Wolftown Community Building is 55 plus years old and desperately needs to be replaced and;

WHEREAS; the pipes have busted in the ceiling and caused water damage on the inside as well as the roof and;

WHEREAS; it is in the best interest to the residents of the Wolftown Community that a new Wolftown Community building be constructed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOVLED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Council hereby approves a feasibility study for cost of demolition and construction of the Wolftown Community Building and that the cost and blueprints be brought before Tribal Council in three months from passage of this resolution so that the funds can be appropriated and the plans to begin demolition of the old building and preparation for a new building can begin

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning Department is instructed to carry out the intent of this resolution which shall become effective upon ratification of the Principal Chief
