Resolution No. _____ (2016)

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council is the governing body for the Tribe and the safety and wellbeing of the Tribal Community is a high priority to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians are a federally recognized Indian Nation with historic and continuing government to government relationship with United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Public Health and Human Services (PHHS), Women's Wellness Program of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, is committed to provide breast and cervical screenings, testing, education, and referrals for eligible women of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians; and

WHEREAS, PHHS provides services to eligible women of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians with a portion of funding from the North Carolina Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (NCBCCCP); and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the communities for the PHHS to participate in the NCBCCCP funded programs.

WHEREAS; the grant budget allows for \$33,150.00 in salaries and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, at which a quorum is present, that the PHHS, Women's Wellness Program of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians be authorized to apply and accept NCBCCCP funds on behalf of the communities to support these programs, up to \$33,150.00 for FY16 - 17.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Principal Chief is authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution, which shall remain in effect until implemented or rescinded.
