A resolution for the Estate of Lilly Ann Sampson Wolfe.

WHEREAS, Lilly Ann Sampson Wolfe (deceased June 20, 2006), enrolled member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians left a Last Will and Testament, dated January 5, 1998, and

WHEREAS, James David Jumper qualified as the Executor of the estate of Lilly Ann Sampson, in Cherokee Court Estate File No. 06-047; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Realty Office has examined the deceased's Will, the records on file regarding the deceased's possessory holdings in Tribal trust land, and other documents, and has written this resolution for Tribal Council may confirm the Last Will and Testament of the deceased and to provide for the distribution of the deceased's possessory holdings to their eligible heirs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council Assembled, at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians does hereby confirm the Last Will and Testament of Lilly Ann Sampson Wolfe, dated January 5, 1998.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that **Wolftown Parcel No. 540-A (Part of Parcel No. 540)**, containing 0.345 Acres, more or less, be assigned to Shaundene Lorenzo Grant (enrolled).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that **Wolftown Parcel No. 540-B (1st Remainder of Parcel No. 540)**, containing 0.641 Acres, more or less, together with all improvements located thereon, be assigned to Shaundene Lorenzo Grant (enrolled).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Committee and the Tribal Realty Services are hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution.
