20		indispensable to the Tribe's autonomy and self-governance; and
21	WHEREAS,	ANDREW JAMES HENRY (DOB 12/1/1976) is not a member of the Eastern

25		Cherokee Tribal Criminal History Records, has been residing on the boundary of the E.B.C.I. since 12/16/2004; and

27	WHEREAS,	Andrew James Henry has been permanently evicted from the Harrah's Cherokee
28		Casino; and

29 30	WHEREAS,	However, on November 3, 2024, while at Harrah's Cherokee Casino, Andrew James Henson, stole a bicycle belonging to William Henry Poolaw of Cherokee;

32	WHEREAS,	Cherokee Indian Police Department has had to deal with ANDREW JAMES
33		HENRY at least 10 times in the last eight years and his criminal history is such
34		that he has both NC and FBI numbers.
35	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council, in Council assembled

37 38		with a quorum present, and with the number of votes required by Tribal law, ANDREW JAMES HENRY is hereby PERMANENTLY EXCLUDED from all
39		Tribal lands and is hereby notified and ordered to vacate all tribal lands.

1	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this permanent exclusion prohibits ANDREW JAMES	
2	HENRY from entering or being present on Tribal lands for any purpose except as	
3	required by Tribal Council or Tribal Court.	
4		
5	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if ANDREW JAMES HENRY is found improperly on	
6	Tribal lands at any time after the effective date of this resolution, he shall be	
7	treated as a trespasser and appropriate legal action shall be taken against him.	
8		
9	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded	
10	and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal	
11	Chief.
