RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2025)
A resolution confirming the EBCI Police Commission

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Police Commission was established in *Cherokee Code Chapter 120*, and,

WHEREAS, tribal law requires that the commission have eight members, two of the members are at large (one male, one female) and six members represent their respective townships, and shall serve three-year terms (*Res. 1012 2009*), and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Cherokee Code 117-42, Confirmation Hearings, Tribal Council held a confirmation hearing on Wednesday, January 15, 2025 for Mr. Buddy Johnson (BigCove Township); Regina Rosario (Painttown Township); Anita Lossiah (Yellowhill Township); Rick Queen (Wolftown Township); Gene "Tunney" Crowe (Birdtown Township); Israel Rodgriquez (Male at-large) Kym Parker (Female At-Large) and Hillary Norville (Snowbird/Cherokee County Townships) was held on Tuesday, January 28, 2025 and all were confirmed unanimously by Tribal Council

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that the following people are hereby established as the Cherokee Police Commission with an expiration date of February 6, 2028

- 1.) BigCove – Buddy Johnson
- 2.) Painttown – Regina Rosario
- 3.) Yellowhill – Anita Lossiah
- 4.) Wolftown – Rick Queen
- 5.) Birdtown – Gene "Tunney" Crowe
- 6.) Snowbird/Cherokee County – Hillary Norville
- 7.) Male At-Large – Israel Rodriguez
- 8.) Female At-Large – Kym Parker

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED within three business days of confirmation each appointee shall contact the Office of Internal Audit and Ethics to schedule mandatory ethics training and to obtain the necessary resources to ensure compliance with the Standards of Ethical Conduct (CC § 117-45)

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief
