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1 **Cherokee Council House** 2 Cherokee, NC 3 4 OCT 3 0 2025 5 Date: 6 7 8 RESOLUTION NO. 26 (2025) 9 10 11 A resolution to reaffirm Part 1, Section 19 of the Charter and Governing Document of the 12 Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians; and Cherokee Code Chapter 117-12 13 14 WHEREAS, Charter and Governing Document of the Eastern Band of the Cherokee Indians 15 explicitly describes the powers created and constitutes the legal framework from 16 which law is created and administered; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Paragraph 2 of section of 19 of the Charter states, "A tribal census, for the purposes 19 of determining the weight of the votes to be cast by each Tribal Council member, 20 shall be conducted prior to the 1981 tribal election and prior to the election each 21 ten years thereafter to determine the number of enrolled tribal members residing in 22 each township"; and 23 24 WHEREAS, Cherokee Code Chapter 117-12 subsection C states, "A Tribal census, for the 25 purpose of determining the weight of the vote to be cast by each Council member, 26 shall be conducted prior to the 1981 Tribal election and prior to the election each 27 ten years thereafter to determine the number of enrolled Tribal members residing 28 in each township. After the regular 1981 Tribal election and each ten years 29 thereafter, the Tribal Council, at its first regular meeting, shall determine the total 30 number of votes to be cast in the Tribal Council and shall allot a voting weight to 31 each Council member. The individual voting weight shall be determined by computing the mathematical ratio, fraction or proportion that exists between the 32 33 number of enrolled Tribal members residing in each township and the total number 34 of enrolled members"; and 35 36 The last update to the weighted vote in Cherokee Code Chapter 117 was in October WHEREAS, 37 2001 via Resolution 20 (2001); and 38 39 Tribal Council approved Resolution 470 (2022) which authorized an electronic WHEREAS, 40 tribal census to be carried out; and 41 42 WHEREAS, A tribal census was administered and completed in 2023; and 43 44 To date no official business has been conducted by Tribal Council to fulfill and WHEREAS, 45 satisfy the tenets of the Charter and Governing Document and Cherokee Code 46 Chapter 117-12 as result of completing the 2023 census.

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3	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee
4	Indians, in Council assembled at which a quorum is present, that the Tribal Council
5	hereby fulfill its responsibility to provide for accurate and fair representation of the
6	constituents of each community by determining an updated weighted vote for each
7	tribal community with (90) days of the passage of this resolution.
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9	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are hereby
10	rescinded, that this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the
11	Principal Chief, and that the Principal Chief be authorized to carry out the intent of
12	this resolution, which shall remain in effect until implemented or rescinded.
