RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2026)

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (EBCI) Cooperative Extension Program is responsible for assisting families and farmers in achieving and maintaining health and productive lives, achieving financial success, while also seeking to assist in the development of local food sovereignty through the support of local food systems; and

WHEREAS, there is a barrier in the ability to access traditional seeds; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Extension Program has identified a funding opportunity from the Dogwood Health Trust to provide resources to build related infrastructure and staffing opportunities to assist in providing infrastructure for a Tribal seed bank; and

WHEREAS, the grant budget allows for an estimated amount of \$60,000 in personnel expenses; and

WHEREAS, there is no grant match required.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in Council assembled and at which a quorum is present, that the EBCI Cooperative Extension Program is authorized to apply for and accept funds from the Dogwood Health Trust in the estimated amount of \$500,000 for FY27-28.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Principal Chief is authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution, which shall remain in effect until implemented or rescinded.
