9	An ordinance to increase the short term rental privilege tax and to allocate funds
10	to the Division of Commerce for tourism and tourism-based economic development.
11	WHEREAS Tribal Council is outhorized and amnouvered to adopt laws and regulations for the
12 13	WHEREAS, Tribal Council is authorized and empowered to adopt laws and regulations for the general government of the Tribe, to govern the management of real and personal
14	property held by the Tribe, and is vested with full power to enforce obedience to
15	such laws and regulations as may be enacted by the Tribe (EBCI Charter and
16	Governing Document § 23); and

18	WHEREAS, Cherokee Code (C.C.) § 105-30 imposes a short term rental privilege tax on the
19	operators of hotels, motels, tourist homes, tourist camps, campgrounds, rental
20	cabins, and similar type businesses and persons who rent private residences and
21 22	cottages to transients; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, C.C. § 105-31 sets the short term rental privilege tax rate at four percent (4 %), and
24	C.C. § 105-33 allocates the collected funds to various Tribal programs; and
25	WHERE A.C. the form remont (40%) torring to an extentially heleve the note improved by
26	WHEREAS, the four percent (4%) tax rate is substantially below the rate imposed by surrounding cities and should be increased to better fund the Tribe's; and
27 28	surrounding ettles and should be increased to better fund the 111be's, and
29	WHEREAS, the Tribe should increase its short term rental privilege tax rate to increase the tax
30	dollars available to the Tribe's Commerce Division for economic development.
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32	NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Tribal
33	Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that C.C. § 105-31 and C.C. §
34	105-33 shall be amended to read as follows:
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36	Sec. 105-31 Rate.
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38	(a) The Privilege Tax rate for hotels, motels, tourist homes, residences and cottages under
39	Subsections 105-30(1) shall be four seven percent of sales price for each room for every
40	day or night it is rented.
41 42	(b) The Privilege Tax rate for tourist camps and campgrounds under Subsections 105-30(1)
43	shall be four seven percent of sales price for each site for every day or night it is rented.
44	percent of outer price for each sice for every day of ingliffe to reflect.
45	(c) The percentage rate of four seven percent of the sales price shall apply on sales starting at
46	12:01 a.m. in the morning of March 1, 2018 January 2, 2023.

Sec. 105-33. - Use of funds.

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(a) All funds collected by the Eastern Band pursuant to this article shall be deposited promptly into a special bank account in the name of the Eastern Band in a bank designated by the Executive Committee, with the funds insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

(b) Twenty-five percent of the one-half of the short-term privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Cherokee Tribal Sanitation Budget, specifically sanitation to eliminate the solid waste user fee for households. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the Tribal Council.

 (c) Fifty percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Travel & Promotion Commerce Division Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the Tribal Council for the purpose of promoting and improving EBCI brands, tourism and tourism-focused economic development. Tourism and shall be used as follows:

(1) To promote the Tribe's bottled water program; and

(2) To help fund events sponsored by the Tribe and held at the Cherokee fairgrounds and other locations in Cherokee and for fairgrounds maintenance.

(d) Three percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Cultural Preservation Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the Tribal Council for the purposes of cultural preservation.

(e) Three percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Youth Sports Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the Tribal Council for the purposes of youth sports.

(f) Three percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Health Transportation Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the Tribal Council for the purposes of travel to medical services.

(g) Three percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Fuel Assistance Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the Tribal Council for the purposes of providing fuel.

(h) Thirteen percent of the privilege tax collected shall be deposited in the Tribal Recreation Program Budget. This fund shall be disbursed in accordance with the annual budget adopted by the Tribal Council for the purpose of providing Tribal recreation programs.

2	rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the
3	Principal Chief.
