RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ (2022)

*A resolution declaring a vacancy on the Board of Elections,  
and providing for an appointment to the Board.*

WHEREAS, Cherokee Code (C.C.) § 161-17 states that the Board of Elections shall be composed of six members, one from each township, and the members are appointed to staggered terms of four years; and

WHEREAS, Lula Jackson was previously appointed to the Board from the Painttown Township; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson resigned her seat on the Board on November 2, 2022, to pursue other opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson's term would have expired on September 1, 2024, and her resignation has created a vacancy on the Board of Elections; and

WHEREAS, C.C. § Sec. 161-18 states that "A vacancy on the Board shall be filled by appointment of a replacement by the Tribal Council at the next regular Council session after the vacancy occurs. Such appointee shall serve the remaining term of the Board member being replaced"; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council should appoint a person from the Painttown Township to fill the seat on the Board of Elections that was vacated by Lula Jackson, for the remainder of Ms. Jackson's term.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Tribal Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that Tribal Council acknowledges that Lula Jackson, from the Painttown Township, has resigned her seat on the Board of Elections, her resignation has created a vacancy on the Board, and the following enrolled member from the Painttown Township is appointed to fill Ms. Jackson's seat on the Board:
