1 CHEROKEE COUNCIL HOUSE 2 CHEROKEE, NORTH CAROLINA 3 SEP 0 7 2023 4 Date: 5 RESOLUTION NO. <u>730</u> (2023) 6 7 8 A resolution to adopt the Ethics Investigation Report dated August 3, 2023, issued by the 9 Office of Internal Audit and Ethics in Case No. 2023-1-63, 10 regarding Jeremy Wilson, and imposing sanctions. 11 WHEREAS, Section 23 of the Charter and Governing Document authorizes and empowers 12 13 Tribal Council to enforce obedience to Tribal laws; and 14 WHEREAS, the Tribe's ethics ordinance, codified at C.C. Sec. 117-45.1 to 117-45.3, requires 15 Tribal officials (defined as persons elected or appointed to their position), to abide 16 17 by certain rules of conduct; and 18 WHEREAS, in response to a written complaint properly filed with the Office of Internal Audit 19 20 and Ethics on January 25, 2023, that office performed an investigation into the 21 conduct of Jeremy Wilson who, at all times relevant to the allegations in the 22 complaint, was a Tribal official; and 23 WHEREAS, in summary, the complaint alleged that during the period beginning in November 24 2021, and ending on August 3, 2022, when his appointment was terminated by the 25 Principal Chief, Mr. Wilson violated the ethics ordinance when he attempted to 26 27 solicit money and personal favors, for his own personal gain, from Sovereign 28 Solutions Carolina, LLC, a contractor of the Tribe; and 29 30 WHEREAS, during the period in question, Mr. Wilson was serving as the Tribe's Governmental Affairs Liaison (an appointed position) and as a member of the Cherokee Medical 31 32 LLC Board (now known as Qualla Enterprises, LLC); and 33 34 WHEREAS, the investigation resulted in an Ethics Investigation Report in Case No. 2023-1-63. In the report, the Office of Internal Audit and Ethics concluded that Mr. Wilson had 35 violated the following provisions of the ethics ordinance: C.C. Sec. 117-45.3(b), 36 117-45.3(d)(1), 117-45.3(d)(5) and 117-45.3(d)(15); and 37 38 WHEREAS, as part of the report, the Audit and Ethics Committee, which is part of the Office of 39 Internal Audit and Ethics, recommended that Mr. Wilson should be sanctioned in 40 41 the following ways: that he should be required to pay a fine of \$4,000, and that he 42 should not be appointed to any position for a period of five years; and 43 44 WHEREAS, this resolution is presented to adopt the findings and conclusions of the Ethics Investigation Report, to make the report part of the record of Tribal Council, and to 45 46 impose sanctions on Mr. Wilson.

2	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that the Ethics Investigation
4	Report dated August 3, 2023, issued by the Office of Internal Audit and Ethics in
6	Case No. 2023-1-63, regarding the conduct of Jeremy Wilson, is hereby accepted and adopted by Tribal Council.
7	
8	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the Ethics Investigation Report is attached and
9	incorporated into to this resolution, and is hereby made part of the official record of Tribal Council.

12	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Tribal Council hereby adopts the recommendation of the
13	Audit and Ethics Committee that Jeremy Wilson shall be fined \$4,000 (four
14	thousand dollars) which shall be a debt to the Tribe for which Mr. Wilson's per
15	capita may be garnished.

18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Jeremy Wilson is prohibited from appointment to any
19	position with the Tribal government or appointment to any position on any entity
20	enterprise, board or commission of the Tribe for years.
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal government and any entity, enterprise, board or
22	commission of the Tribe shall not enter any contracts for goods or services with
23	Jeremy Wilson or any business entity for which he is a principal, for
24	years.

26 27	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are
28	rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
