Painttown Parcel No. 297, otherwise known as Painttown Gym, was granted a use permit for athletic purpose for the community for as long as it was used in the capacity of an athletic center capacity

WHEREAS;

Charles I. Hornbuckle did not transfer possessory holdings and specifically requested in the use permit that in the event that this acre was no longer used for athletic purposes it would revert back to the family

WHEREAS;

the Painttown Gym has ceased to be used for athletic purposes since 2014

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Annual Council assembled, at which a quorum is present that the research on the topic has been done by Tribal Lands Department; and the Heirs of Charles I. Hornbuckle request this parcel be returned to its original state before the gym was built and the Heirs of Charles I. Hornbuckle retain possessory holding free and clear of any before mentioned use permit

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded and that this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief.
