RESOLUTION NO.	(2018))

- WHEREAS, the Charter and Governing Document authorizes and empowers the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (EBCI) Tribal Council to govern the management of real and personal property held by the Tribe. Charter and Governing Document, sect. 16 and 23 (Sept. 5, 1995).
- WHEREAS, the EBCI Tribal Council possess legislative authority. C.C. §117-10.
- WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians passed and ratified Resolution 669 (2011) which instructed the Kituwah Preservation & Education Program to start an immersion program in the Snowbird Community. Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council Resolution No. 669 (April 25 2011).
- WHEREAS, the Snowbird Community requested the immersion program to preserve the distinct dialect and speaking traditions of the Snowbird people. *Id*.
- WHEREAS, there is a building available to house the immersion program located beside the new Snowbird Daycare Facility.
- WHEREAS, the building beside the new daycare facility is a convenient location for the immersion program.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, the Tribal Council instructs the Office of the Principal Chief to designate the building beside the new Snowbird daycare facility as the Snowbird Community Language and Cultural Arts Center.
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Office of the Principal Chief shall carry out the intent of this resolution and this resolution shall become effective upon the Principal Chief's ratification.
