RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2018)

WHEREAS, the Charter and Governing Document authorizes and empowers the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (EBCI) Tribal Council to govern the management of real and personal property held by the Tribe. Charter and Governing Document, sect. 16 and 23 (Sept. 5, 1995).

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Code sets forth the Tribal Reserve boundaries. C.C. §47-16 and 17.

WHEREAS, Tribal Council may give written consent for EBCI enrolled members to remove rock from the Tribal Reserve. C.C. §14-10.10(d).

WHEREAS, Jacob Jackson Ivey is an EBCI member who desires Tribal Council's permission to obtain a rock removal permit from the William Cove area, located in the 3200 Acre Tract Community.

WHEREAS, Mr. Ivey is willing to pay the tribe their proportionate stumpage share.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, the Tribal Council permits Jacob Jackson Ivey to gather building stone in the Tribal Reserve, specifically from the 3200 Acre Tract Community section known as the William Cove Area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED Tribal Council grants Jacob Jackson Ivey a one-year permit which shall begin upon Business Committee approval. C.C. § 117-33(a).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Ivey shall pay his proportionate share of stumpage at eight dollars (\$8.00) per ton.

BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Committee and the Tribal Realty Division shall carry out the intent of this resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED this resolution shall become effective upon the Principal Chief's ratification.
