- WHEREAS, The Tribe owns Upper Cherokee Community Parcel 60-C. (See Attached GIS map). An old water tower is on this site.
- WHEREAS, The Board of Elections needs a new building so that it may carry its responsibilities pursuant to the Cherokee Code.
- WHEREAS, Cherokee Code Section 161-19 gives the Board of Elections authority to seek suitable office space to perform the duties of the Board.
- WHEREAS, The EBCI Government will fund and construct the building.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians assembled, at which a quorum is present, that the Tribal Council hereby gives the use of a portion of Upper Cherokee Community Parcel 60-C where the old water tower was located to the Board of Elections to be used for office space to carry out the duties of the Board.
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
