(2018) 8 9 WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 236 (May 5, 2016), Tribal Council confirmed the Last Will and Testament of Beatrice Carver dated September 26, 2011, and provided for the 10 assignment of the deceased's possessory holdings to her enrolled member 11 granddaughter, Abby Swayney, as provided in the will; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, the will also provided that the deceased's children, Rhonda Carver and Chad Carver, who are first generation descendants occupying two possessory holdings 15 of the deceased, should be allowed to live in their respective homes "for as long 16 as they wish to do so"; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, Rhonda Carver lives on Wolfetown Community Parcel No. 646 (Part of Parcel No. 461), containing 0.653 acres more or less, (98 Dobson Ridge Road) and Chad 20 Carver occupies Wolfetown Community Parcel No. 1193-C (Part of Parcel No. 21 22 1193-A) containing 1.244 acres more or less, (94 Dobson Ridge Road); and 23 Resolution No. 236 was amended to require Abby Swayney to "issue a permit in 24 WHEREAS, 25 the name of Rhonda Rae Carver to occupy the home located at 98 Dobson Ridge Road for five years with an option to renew to be exercised by the land owner". 26 The resolution also required Ms. Swayney to issue a permit to Chad Eric Carver 27 "for the term of the current mortgage on the property with an option to renew to 28 be exercised by the landowner"; and 29 30 WHEREAS, Rhonda Carver is Abby Swayney's mother and Chad Carver is Abby Swayney's 31 uncle; and 32 33 Ms. Swayney has not issued the permits required in the resolution. Regarding 34 WHEREAS. Chad Carver's residence, Ms. Swayney was prevented from doing so because the 35 residence was encumbered by a financing lease and assignment of the property to 36 the Tribe. There is also considerable discord between among the parties; and 37 38 39 WHEREAS, due to the legal obstacle to Chad Carver's permit, the Attorney General, members of the Tribal Realty Office and members of the BIA met with Ms. Swayney, 40 Rhonda Carver and Chad Carver and concluded that the Attorney General should 41 42 present a corrective resolution to Tribal Council so the goal and intent of the prior resolution could be achieved. At the meeting, Ms. Swayney stated that she would 43 consider giving Rhonda Carver and Chad Carver life estates in the respective 44 properties; and 45 46

WHEREAS, after that meeting, Ms. Swayney paid-off the loan that encumbered Chad Carver's 1 residence and has filed an action in Cherokee Court to evict him; and 2 3 WHEREAS, Tribal Council should pass this resolution to effectuate the intent of Resolution 4 No. 236 (2016), which was to give Rhonda Carver and Chad Carver a defined 5 period of years in which they can continue to live in their homes. 6 7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council 8 Assembled, at which a quorum is present, that Resolution No. 236 (May 5, 2016) 9 is amended as follows: 10 11 (1) Rhonda Rae Carver shall have possession, occupancy and control of 12 Wolfetown Community Parcel No. 646 (Part of Parcel No. 461), containing 13 0.653 acres more or less, (98 Dobson Ridge Road), including the 14 improvements thereon, exclusive of the interests of Abby Gayle Grace 15 Swayney, for five-years beginning on May 5, 2016, which five-year period 16 may be renewed as many times as desired upon the consent of the holder of 17 the possessory interest (currently Abby Gayle Grace Swayney). 18 19 (2) Chad Carver shall have possession, occupancy and control of Wolfetown 20 Community Parcel No. 1193-C (Part of Parcel No. 1193-A) containing 1.244 21 acres more or less, (94 Dobson Ridge Road), exclusive of the interests of 22 Abby Gayle Grace Swayney, for five-years beginning on May 5, 2016, which 23 five-year period may be renewed as many times as desired upon the consent 24 of the holder of the possessory interest (currently Abby Gayle Grace 25 Swayney). 26 27 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Committee and the Tribal Realty Services 28 are hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution. 29 30 31 32 Submitted by the Office of the Attorney General and Tribal Realty Services 33 34 35
