RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ (2018)

WHEREAS, there is \$55,277.27 available from the Bureau of Indian Affairs' Forest Management Deductions (FMD) Trust Asset Account Management System to the Tribe through the Tribal Timber & Natural Resources Committee; and

WHEREAS, there currently isn't an approved tribal expenditure plan developed for the use of this money at this time, it is therefore requested that this money be deferred for use until a later time when a plan can be developed, and approved by the Eastern Regional Office; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for Tribal Council to approve by Tribal resolution the deferment of these FMD monies until a future date.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, the Tribal Council hereby approves the deferment of the \$55,277.27 in Forest Management Deductions monies, and approves these monies to be kept in the TAAMS FMD account for future use when needed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribe's TAAMS FMD account shall maintain these funds and shall carry out the intent of this resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief.
