RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2018)

WHEREAS, Julius Francis Taylor (deceased April 14, 2005), enrolled member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, left a Last Will and Testament dated October 30, 2000; and

WHEREAS, an estate was opened for the deceased in Cherokee Court estate file no. 05-133 and the only asset in the estate left to be distributed is a single possessory holding; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Realty Office has examined the deceased's Will, the records on file regarding the deceased's possessory holdings in Tribal trust land, and other documents, and has written this resolution to provide for the distribution of the deceased's possessory holding to his eligible heirs; and

WHEREAS, the Executor requests Tribal Council to confirm the Last Will and Testament of Julius Francis Taylor, to recognize his eligible heirs under Tribal law, and to provide for the distribution of his possessory holding to his eligible heirs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council Assembled, at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians does hereby confirm the Last Will and Testament of Julius Francis Taylor, dated October 30, 2000, for purposes of distribution of the deceased's possessory holdings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that **Wolfetown Community Parcel No. 1332-B (Part of Parcel No. 1332)**, containing 8.761 acres, more or less, be assigned to Lovedy Paige Wachacha Gross (enrolled), Alyssa Nichelle Taylor (enrolled), and Sydney Neriah Taylor (enrolled).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rest, remainder and residue of any possessory holdings in the estate shall be assigned equally between Lisa Dessie Wiggins (enrolled) and Lovedy Paige Wachacha Gross (enrolled).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Committee and the Tribal Realty Department are hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution.
