Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_ (2018)

WHEREAS, Cherokee Code Section 161-7 provides the Election Board establishment as follows;

- (a) the Board of Elections shall be composed of six members, one from each township. Each member of the Board shall be appointed by the Tribal Council effective September 1 in non-election years, with the term of each member to run for four years from that date. The terms shall be staggered with one representative appointed from Painttown, Wolftown/BigY, Snowbird/Cherokee County in 2012 and each four years thereafter; and one representative appointed from Big Cove, Birdtown and Yellowhill in 2014 and each four years thereafter

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 338 (2018) was amended and passed on September 6, 2018 which appointed Birdtown and Yellowhill's representative to the Election Board and the amendment was to strike the Big Cove appointment from that resolution, that appointment is now ready to be filled

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Annual Council assembled at which a quorum is present that Tribal Council appoints the following individual to serve as Big Cove's representative on the Election Board

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this newly appointed Election Board Member will serve a term of four years which will begin September 1, 2018 and expire August 30, 2022

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief
