- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 15 (2009) authorized approval for TCGE and TBE to withdraw from the EBCI retirement plan; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 139 (2010) established the new Tribal Employee Benefits Committee (TEBC) and the TEBC was slightly changed in Resolution 698 (2017); and
- WHEREAS, When TCGE and TBE went out on their own it was anticipated that the Tribe and the remaining Entities would comply with the Pension Protection Act of 2006 and create a new governmental and commercial defined benefit plan; and
- WHEREAS, The Governmental and Commercial Defined Benefit Plans both provide for 5year vesting. A participant in either plan must work for 5 years to receive a retirement benefit; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council would like the vesting period extended to ten (10) years for new employees and this is only permissible for the Governmental Plan.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians assembled, at which a quorum is present, that the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Governmental Retirement Plan shall be amended as necessary so that a Participant shall only be vested and receive an Accrued Benefit when the Participant has 10 or more Years of Service.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the new 10-year vesting period shall be effective for employees whose first day of employment is after December 31, 2018.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Employee Benefits Committee and the Principal Chief are authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution.
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
