WHEREAS; The EBCI and Southern Appalachian Man and Biosphere (SAMAB) have partnered

since the Chief Youngdeer administration to protect and manage natural

resources in the Southern Appalachian Region; and

WHEREAS; SAMAB is a multi-agency partnership consisting of federal and state entities,

regional universities and other natural resource non-profit organizations; and

WHEREAS; The EBCI's Natural Resource Department and EBCI community members have

been involved in the creation of the attached Culturally Significate Plant Initiative (CSPI) to enhance collaboration and prioritize the EBCl's perspective and use of culturally significant plants and tree species within the SAMAB region; and

WHEREAS; The CSPI would support EBCI Natural Resources program objectives by expanding

partnerships and implementing culturally significant plant conservation initiatives utilizing modern scientific research and EBCI Traditional Ecological

Knowledge.

WHEREAS; SAMAB and the CSPI respects the relationship the EBCI has with these trees and

plants by honoring the privacy of sensitive information and requiring the consent of the EBCI before any information or publication is released as stated in the

attached document; and

WHEREAS; The EBCI reserves the right to end its participation in the CSPI should we feel our

culture or traditional knowledge are not being properly respected or the

collaboration is not meeting the EBCl's sovereign objectives.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that Tribal Council hereby approves the Culturally Significant Plant Initiative and supports participation by the Natural Resource Department and Tribal Community; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief.
