(2018) 8 9 WHEREAS, Martha Junaluska Taylor, (deceased October 23, 2014), enrolled member of the 10 Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians left a Last Will and Testament, dated October 11 12 19, 1971, and 13 14 WHEREAS, Lowen Truman Taylor has qualified as the Executor of the estate of Martha 15 Junaluska Taylor in Cherokee Court Estate File No. 14-092; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Tribal Realty Office has examined the deceased's Will, the records on file regarding the deceased's possessory holding in Tribal trust land, and other 18 documents, and has written this resolution to provide for the distribution of the 19 deceased's possessory holding to her eligible heir; and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, the deceased's will states that Birdtown Community Parcel No. 80, where her 23 mutual-help house is located, be distributed to her daughter, Betsy Lou Taylor: and 24 25 26 WHEREAS, the deceased transferred out most of Parcel No. 80 and kept for herself Birdtown 27 Community Parcel No. 136 in order to participate in the mutual-help housing 28 program, and it is the only asset in the estate; and 29 30 WHEREAS, the will states that the deceased had already provided for her other children during her lifetime and this is the reason the deceased left the remainder of her estate to 31 Betsy Lou Taylor; and 33 34 WHEREAS, the Executor requests Tribal Council to confirm the Last Will and Testament of 35
