NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOVLED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that Tribal Council instructs Housing and Community Development to move the trailer I have purchased to my house site located in the Wolftown Community, Parcel No. 1370-B containing 1.028 acres, more or less

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Secretary of Housing shall carry out the intent of this resolution and this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief
