	WHEREAS,	the current TGC commissioners are Robert "Birdie" Saunooke, Walter "Dan" McCoy, and Bentley Tahquette; and
	WHEREAS,	Robert Saunooke was appointed by Resolution No. 5 (October 5, 2015), Walter "Dan" McCoy was appointed by Resolution No. 6 (October 5, 2015), and Bentley Tahquette was appointed by Resolution No. 127 (February 6, 2016). All of these appointments were made by Principal Chief Patrick H. Lambert and the appointments were approved by Tribal Council; and
	WHEREAS,	Saunooke, McCoy and Tahquette were appointed to fill the seats made vacant by the simultaneous removal of all three of the prior Commissioners (Robert Blankenship, Donald Rose and Shiela Brown) by Resolution No. 4 (October 5, 2015); and
	WHEREAS,	none of the resolutions that appointed Saunooke, McCoy and Tahquette expressed what seats they were filling or who they were replacing. Further, Resolution No. 5 (2015) (appointing Saunooke) and Resolution No. 6 (2015) (appointing McCoy) did not express a term length or an expiration date, and Resolution No. 127 (2016) (appointing Tahquette) stated only that his term would be for five years; and
	WHEREAS,	the terms of Saunooke, McCoy and Tahquette cannot be measured from the simultaneous removal of Blankenship, Rose and Brown on October 5, 2015, because to do so would ignore the requirement for staggered terms; and
	WHEREAS,	by tracing the respective seats back through their appointment history, it has been determined that the term of Robert "Birdie" Saunooke will expire on December 31, 2019; the term of Walter "Dan" McCoy expired on December 31, 2018; and the term of Bentley Tahquette expired on December 31, 2017; and
