RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2019)

WHEREAS, Bernadine Hicks George, (deceased November 14, 2016), enrolled member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians did not leave a Last Will and Testament; and

WHEREAS, Denise George has qualified as the Administratrix of the estate of Bernadine Hicks George in Cherokee Court Estate File No. 17-013; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Realty Office has examined the records on file regarding the deceased's possessory holdings in Tribal trust land, and other documents, and has written this resolution to provide for the distribution of the deceased's possessory holdings to her eligible heirs; and

WHEREAS, the Administratrix requests Tribal Council recognize the deceased's eligible heirs under Tribal law, and to provide for the distribution of the deceased's possessory holdings to her eligible heirs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council Assembled, at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians does hereby recognize the heirs of Bernadine Hicks George: Denise George (enrolled) and Terri Jo Beck (enrolled).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a ½ undivided interest in **Wolfetown Community Parcel No. 978-B (Remainder of Parcel No. 978)**, containing 7.255 acres, more or less, be assigned to Denise George (enrolled) and Terri Jo Beck (enrolled).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that **Painttown Community Parcel No. 826-A**, containing 0.375 acres, more or less, be assigned to Denise George (enrolled) and Terri Jo Beck (enrolled).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that **Painttown Community Parcel No. 826-B**, containing 0.631 acres, more or less, be assigned to Denise George (enrolled) and Terri Jo Beck (enrolled).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Business Committee and the Tribal Realty Services are hereby authorized to carry out the intent of this resolution.
