## RESOLUTION No. 476 (2019)

**WHEREAS**, The Cherokee speaking population has reached a critical state; and

WHEREAS, the Kituwah Preservation & Education Program's primary responsibility is to coordinate and facilitate Cherokee language activities and projects to maintain the language and increase fluency among Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Kituwah Preservation and Education Program has identified a funding source from the Cherokee Preservation Foundation:

Revitalization of Traditional Cherokee Artisan Resources

(RTCAR); and

WHEREAS, the Kituwah Preservation and Education Program is requesting funding from the Cherokee Preservation Foundation to assist with a gardening project that will bring together fluent speakers with Pre-K through 6<sup>th</sup> grade language immersion students for the dual purpose of language and traditional gardening food preparation, and edible native plant knowledge; and

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Preservation Foundation requires at least 50% match, which The Kituwah Preservation and Education Program shall commit a match totaling \$6,799.00 (In-Kind); and

**WHEREAS**, the grant budget does not include salaries and to continue to receive these funds an application is required once the grant project is completed; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians at which a quorum is present that Kituwah Preservation and Education Program be authorized to submit an application package to The Cherokee Preservation Foundation (CPF) in the amount of \$6,462.00 for fiscal year 2019 for a total project of \$13,241.00.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Principal Chief of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians carry out the intent of this resolution, which shall remain in effect until implemented or rescinded.
