Resolution No. 510 (2019)

WHEREAS, part of the original Cherokee culture are the Wampum belts, woven with purple and white shell beads, the first one was given to the Cherokee by the peacemaker, by the time of the removal seven wampum belts went with the Cherokee People to Oklahoma and still exist today with the United Keetowah Band, and,

WHEREAS, General Grant is working on re-creating those seven Wampum belts with genuine Wampum shell beads and will make the accessible to the members of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians and the public to preserve and/or create a continued interest in the Cherokee identity and culture, and,

WHEREAS, General Grant already recreated one of the seven belts by his own means over a period of 25 years and would like to expedite the processes of making the other six Wampum belts

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Council hereby approve the amount of _____ to help finance the material, raw shell, manufacturing of beads, labor and construction of the belts and the gathering of written information from the UKB in Oklahoma

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this amount shall come from the _____ line item

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief
