- WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Tribal Council is the duly authorized governing body of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians and is responsible for the health, safety, education and welfare of all enrolled members; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council has the authority to promulgate ordinances, resolutions, institute regulations and consider various legal matters that fall within the authority of a federally recognized Indian Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal government, through the Tribal Construction Program, has taken increased responsibility for completion of construction projects on and off the Qualla Boundary; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council grants limited waiver of sovereign immunity and accepts the jurisdiction of the United States Federal Court in matters regarding these projects; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council designates the Manager, Office of Environment and Natural Resources, as the certifying officer to assure that the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and local environmental codes and ordinances are met; and
- WHEREAS, the construction of any project authorized under this resolution will not be commenced until adequate consideration is given to the effects upon the environment and an appropriate determination is issued; and
- NOW THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Construction Program of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Operations Division is authorized to enter into Public Law 93-638 Title V Construction Agreements with the Nashville Area Indian Health Service for the purpose of administering Public Law 86-121 Sanitation Facilities Construction Projects awarded during fiscal year 2019; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Construction Program is authorized to initiate all documentation in regard to funding the following project(s) and that the Principal Chief is authorized to execute said funding agreement on behalf of the EBCI.
