WHEREAS, Mr. Eddie Swimmer, enrolled member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians and resident of the Big Cove Community was the very first World Champion Hoop Dancer; and

WHEREAS, on February 8 & 9, 2020, top American Indian and Canadian First Nations hoop dancers will compete at the Heard Museum for the prestigious World Champion title; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians has been presented with the opportunity to be a major sponsor of the 2020 World Championship Hoop Dance Contest.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in council assembled, at which a quorum is present, the amount of \$10,000.00 shall be budgeted and contributed from One-Time Donations of the tribe's General Fund in the FY2020 budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED the Principal Chief and Office of Budget & Finance shall carryout the intent of this resolution.
