**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ (2019)**

WHEREAS, Tribal law requires the Principal Chief to appoint persons to serve on the Tribal Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission (TABCC) and the appointments are subject to approval by Tribal Council. (C.C. § 18B-200); and

WHEREAS, the TABCC is required to have five members who serve staggered four-year terms. Successive terms are allowed. (C.C. § 18B-200(c)); and

WHEREAS, the incumbent chairman of the TABCC is Pepper Taylor, whose term has expired and who has demonstrated his knowledge and commitment to the TABCC by his good service on the Commission; and

WHEREAS, Principal Chief Richard G. Sneed desires to re-appoint Pepper Taylor to the TABCC for another four-year term.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in Tribal Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that Pepper Taylor, an incumbent member of the TABCC whose terms has expired, and who is qualified and committed to the lawful and proper conduct of the Commission, is hereby re-appointed by Principal Chief Richard G. Sneed to serve a successive four-year term on the TABCC. Mr. Taylor's term will expire on the anniversary of this re-appointment in 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tribal Council hereby approves the re-appointment of Pepper Taylor to the TABCC for a four-year term, subject to removal for cause as provided by law.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
