RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2019)

WHEREAS, the TERO Commission has seven members, two of whom are appointed by the Principal Chief to serve four-year terms concurrently with the term of the Principal Chief who appoints them. (C.C. § 92-5(b)); and

WHEREAS, if a seat on the TERO Commission becomes vacant, the vacancy may be filled only by the appointing authority. (C.C. § 92-5(d)); and

WHEREAS, Kevin Jackson was appointed in Resolution No. 91 (2015) by then-Principal Chief Patrick Lambert to serve on the TERO Commission until September, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Kevin Jackson has submitted to Principal Chief Richard G. Sneed a letter of resignation "effective immediately", thereby removing himself from the TERO Commission and creating a vacancy; and

WHEREAS, Principal Chief Richard G. Sneed desires to appoint the person identified below to fill the vacancy created by Kevin Jackson's resignation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in Tribal Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, that the person named in this paragraph is appointed to fill the vacancy on the TERO Commission created by the resignation of Kevin Jackson from the Commission:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the person named to fill the vacancy shall serve the balance of Kevin Jackson's term on the TERO Commission.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
