RESOLUTION NO. _____ (2019)

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Police Commission oversees Tribal law enforcement programs, including personnel actions and internal investigations; and

WHEREAS, the Commission consists of eight members representing the six Tribal townships, and each member is nominated by the Principal Chief and approved by Tribal Council. (C.C. § 120-4); and

WHEREAS, David Ensley, representing the Painttown Township, was a duly appointed member of the Commission and served on it until his recent death; and

WHEREAS, Principal Chief Richard G. Sneed hereby nominates the Tribal member named below to fill the vacancy created on the Commission when Dave Ensley died, and the Tribal Council hereby approves the person named below; and

WHEREAS, the Cherokee Police Commission ordinance (C.C. Chapter 120) does not express the duration of the commissioners' terms, therefore it is appropriate to express that duration in this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, in Tribal Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, the person named below is nominated by Principal Chief Richard G. Sneed to fill the seat on the Cherokee Police Commission made vacant due to the passing of Commission member David Ensley, representing the Painttown Township, and the person named below is hereby approved by Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that person nominated and approved by this resolution shall serve on the Cherokee Police Commission for a term that will expire on the following date: _____.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions that are inconsistent with this resolution are rescinded, and that this resolution shall become effective when ratified by the Principal Chief.
