Resolution No. _____ (2019)

WHEREAS, the Public Health & Human Services (PHHS) Division' s Tsalagi Public Health aims to prevent injuries to children and encourage safety in the community through education and hands-on training from the Safe Kids Cherokee program; and

WHEREAS, the Tsalagi Public Health Program is eligible and wish to participate in the Great Smokies Health Foundation grant programs for initiatives to benefit the Safe Kids Cherokee program; and

WHEREAS, the program plans to utilize any future grant funds from Great Smokies Health Foundation for children' s safety initiatives like purchasing car seats, fire prevention, hosting medicine drop events, hot car safety, and any other measures that can educate our community about child safety; and

WHEREAS, no match requirement is necessary for the grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant budget does not include salaries; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled where a quorum is present that the Tsalagi Public Health Program of the Eastern Band Cherokee Indians Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) Division be authorized to apply and accept funds from the Great Smokies Health Foundation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon passage of this resolution that this will be a continuing resolution and that the EBCI agrees to accept these funds as external funds are distributed with no requirement of additional cash match other than their approved Tribal budget.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Principal Chief is authorized to carry out the intent of the resolution, which shall remain in effect until implemented or rescinded.
