WHEREAS, Resolution 467 (1985) was passed that asked for the land dispute between the William Larch heirs, Sally Hornbuckle, and Callie Wachacha be re-opened for a new investigation since the legal heirs of David Larch were not considered in the previous decision of the Tribe and;

WHEREAS, Mr. Herbert Wachacha feels that when the decision was made dealing with this property it was made with error because it was stated that there were no heirs, when in fact he had siblings who weren't notified

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians in Council assembled at which a quorum is present that the Tribal Council instruct someone from the Legal Office and the Realty Department assist and guide Mr. Herbert Wachacha in the procedure needed to clarify this error that he feels was done with this property that belonged to his brother Mark Eugene Wachacha (d)

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Realty Department and Attorney General's Office will carry out the intent of this resolution and that this resolution shall become effective upon ratification by the Principal Chief
